All pupils and staff have access to soap within toilets and classrooms. We would recommend providing your child with a pack of tissues and hand wash/sanitiser for their personal use as required. There are general principles anyone can follow to help prevent the spread of respiratory viruses, including: • washing your hands often - with soap and water, or use alcohol based hand sanitiser if
  - washing your hands often with soap and water, or use alcohol based hand sanitiser if handwashing facilities are not available. This is particularly important after taking public transport
  - covering your cough or sneeze with a tissue, then throwing the tissue in a bin.
  - people who feel unwell should stay at home and should not attend work or any education or early learning and childcare setting
  - children, pupils, students, staff and visitors should wash their hands:
    - o before leaving home
    - on arrival at school/setting
    - after using the toilet
    - after breaks and sporting activities
    - before food preparation
    - before eating any food, including snacks
    - before leaving school/setting
  - use an alcohol based hand sanitiser that contains at least 60% alcohol if soap and water are not available
  - avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands
  - avoid close contact with people who are unwell
  - clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces
